The children spend a happy and stimulating day in a comfortable and secure environment. School Hours, Arrival, Collection and Waiting class

You may drop off your child from 07h00, all our teachers are on duty in their classes. If you are going to be late for school due to unforeseen circumstances please inform your class teacher, she can then let Uncle Sim know - and he can keep an eye out by the gate for your arrival.

The Maple class end their day at 12h30
The Chestnuts class end their day at 12h45
The Willow class end their day at 13h00

A waiting class is available until 13h45. Between the time your child ends class to the time waiting class ends/ your child is fetched for half day, there are activities provided, such as free- play, dance sessions, outdoor play, messy play and quite time in the library. If you would like, you can pack 'extra' snacks - chips / biscuits / sweeties ect.. for them to eat during this time. Children not collected by 13h45 will be sent to aftercare and be charged daily rates.

If your child is staying for full day, they will have a nap (please provide a pillow and blanket) when they are awake, they will eat and engage in various activities until they are collected at NO LATER THAN 17H00

Intra murals

Our intra mural program is offered during school times. These are activities over and above the normal curriculum. We have commenced with our intra mural program over the past weeks and the children have really engaged well in each intra mural.

Extra Murals

Our extra mural program will begin by the 3rd week in February. This is an additional charge and is paid directly to the extra mural instructors. They will be doing demos during the next two weeks for each child to try and see if they enjoy the program. A letter will be sent out and it would be at your discretion whether or not you would want your child to participate.

Baker Baker

Children get the opportunity to be baker - baker on a rotational basis. The chosen baker - baker can bring home-made goods which they have baked with their parents to school.

Each child will bring R5.00 to school to buy the baked goodies from the week's baker - baker. All monies collected throughout the year gets donated to a charity organisation nominated by the school.



Nutrition

At The Mustard Seed we do our best to encourage your child to eat the meals prepared daily. Most children fall into the routine of mealtime with no trouble. We do not force nor punish children who do not want to eat as we do not want negative associations with mealtimes. Our kitchen cooks fresh, healthy, kid friendly meals covering all major food groups. Our meals are balanced, nutritious, and designed with young pallets in mind. We have a 4- week rotation menu which will be stuck into the diary.
